

Rhyll Boating Facility Upgrade

Update

SEPTEMBER 2020



Rhyll Boating Facility is one of six boating facilities the government committed to upgrade as part of its unprecedented investment in recreational boating.

These facilities were selected based on advice from various stakeholders including the boating and angling community.

What's happened so far

We engaged a specialist port and coastal engineering firm to develop three draft concepts that we consulted the community on.

We used the feedback we received to inform a final concept design the community supports that was released in February 2020.

A Heritage Impact Statement has been conducted with recommendations to ensure proposed works at the Rhyll Boating facility are managed to minimise impact to known shipwrecks in the vicinity.

In addition, an assessment has been done to identify Aboriginal and historical cultural heritage values that may be present within the project area.

The findings of both reports have been finalised and will be presented to the Project Control Group (PCG) for comment at a meeting scheduled for late September.

We have convened a PCG to provide guidance on the project. The PCG includes representatives from Bass Coast Shire Council, Parks Victoria, Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP), Maritime Safety Victoria (MSV) and Victorian Fisheries Authority (VFA).

The PCG's role is to provide advice and support on key issues including planning and consents required for successful delivery; ensuring the detailed design meets project objectives and requirements; providing leadership, guidance and direction to the Project Manager on the management of the project. The first PCG briefing took place in July.

A Project Manager has been appointed to oversee the project and undertake the procurement process to appoint contractors to deliver works. Better Boating Victoria and Bass Coast Shire Council will oversee this process.





What's happening right now

Project Manager is preparing a project plan which includes timeframes for delivery of the project.

We recognise the importance of community input and have commenced the establishment of a Project Reference Group (PRG) that will include community members. The role of this group will be to provide feedback on issues relating to the Rhyll Boating Facility Upgrade.

The PRG will also be involved in helping us develop heritage signage for the project area and guide the design of the new playground in consultation with local parents and carers.

What's happening next

The project plan will be finalised, and tender documents will be developed for the detailed technical designs required for the upgrade.
